Artwork Requirements All works must be professionally presented, display-ready and wired for hanging.

All work must be signed somewhere on the piece.

Works must not exceed 42" in either direction. INCLUDING mat and frame. The decision of PAI is final as to the selection and placement of work.

Work may not be withdrawn before the close of the exhibition.

Please use Plexiglas. Weill Cornell is not responsible for breakage or replacement.

Artwork may be marked for sale. Although there will be no commission required on sales of works, a contribution of 20% to the PAI is traditional and will be gratefully accepted and acknowledged.

Marketing and Sales

We encourage all artists to notify their collectors of the presence of their work in the show. Successful strategies have included mailings, personal notes or email blasts to customers with an image informing clients and collectors of the upcoming shows and dates. Members who have done this have had more success than those who have not.

Removal of Work

Works must be removed immediately after exhibition closes. September 7th and 8th 2017

Liability

Weill Cornell will not be responsible for loss, fire, burglary, or any other damage to art work submitted. Accepted work will remain as placed by the Art Committee and may not be moved or withdrawn before the close of the exhibition. Images of accepted artwork may be used for publicity advertising, or other purposes of the show.
